The Yisra'el Nation does not accept your report as being accurate. Below are some discrepancies that need to be addressed as your survey of the situation and status of The Yisra'el Nation is flawed.

Survey: Shelby man says he has established his own 'kingdom'

Correction: The Yisra'el Nation is not a kingdom, it is a recognized Independent State by the US Department of State and other courts in the United States of America. Livingway is not the leader of the State. Keith Edward Livingway is just holding the office for the Secretary until proper elections can be held.

Survey: Shelby man

Correction: Once someone has declared "exile" from the previous state, they are no longer subjects of another State or state ie.. "Shelby man". This is a long standing Law between States. In other words, Keith Edward Livingway is no longer a son of the "City of Shelbyville" nor the United States, and the United States agreed.

Survey: "But the thing is, each time they fill up their gas tank, they're paying state and federal tax on that gasoline, so they're in essence, paying into the government. They may not see it that way, but that's the reality of it."

Correction: The decision to create an Independent State had nothing to do with taxes and The Yisra'el Nation is happy to support the economy of the United States in any way that we possibly can.

Survey: Kentucky State Trooper Kevin Calhoun said he doesn't think so, adding that beliefs such as this are more common in eastern Kentucky, and that he had heard of someone years ago behaving in a similar fashion in Shelby County.

Correction: Kevin Calhoun believes he is a Kentucky State Trooper, so The Yisra'el Nation respects that belief. Kevin has his political views and they are respected. The Yisra'el Nation does not grab Kevin, and then force him into a subject of The Yisra'el Nation and fine him if he does not agree.

Survey: But when he manufactured his own driver's license, issued by himself as secretary of his own state,

Correction: The Yisra'el Nation driving permit is issued by The Yisra'el Nation, a recognized Independent State. Those within the recognized metes and bounds boundaries and borders of The Yisra'el Nation are not permitted to manufacture their own driver's license. The Yisra'el Nation is not a state that applied

for statehood according to the covenant of political and civil rights agreed upon in 2001 by the United States and the United States of America. The Yisra'el Nation is an Independent State, completely different. The differences are that The Yisra'el Nation deals with Treaty Law which by all of your state constitutions is the Law of the Land. If a treaty is in place as in this situation, there is no need to enforce local, state and federal law, the treaty covers everything. In this case: 101220-000071 is the International Incident number issued by the bureau of public affairs in the US Department of State for Treaty Violation by Shelby County along with a host of violations that are required to be addressed. The Yisra'el Nation hopes to resolve this International Incident quickly and in a peaceful manner. There is no need to scare the residents of Shelby County nor is there any reason to report The Yisra'el Nation political views like a circus side show.
