REPORT

COMES NOW, the Human Rights Defenders International with a report on new evidence so discovered in the above referenced **Case # 05BB1C6D-6359-4820-B1CA-7F460E85A84C**, and

QUESTIONS FOR THE STATE OF TENNESSEE

This line of questioning is for the purpose of Human Rights Violations investigation in the **State of Tennessee**. After one of the Human Rights Defenders was detained under a quasi-contempt of court charge, certain human rights violations were witnessed in the State of Tennessee.

The Human Rights Violations were witnessed in Bradley County, Tennessee under the absolute control Of **Randolph Sheridan**, and

1. There were two specific codes mentioned by the Human Rights Defender and their meaning:

A: Code: “He’s not from here”

Meaning: “*He’s not one of us*”

B: Code: “He speaks a foreign language”

Meaning: “*Do what you want; beat him beyond recognition, kill him, rape him...whatever*”

QUESTIONS

1. **Are these inmate codes for Beat or Kill the outsider?**

Answer: “*Yes, these codes are passed along from the Bench, via the Guards themselves, to the inmates, while the outsider is being shuffled through the system, from one section to the next, as they go to Booking, then to the Pods (cell blocks).*”

2. Are there murders of inmates in Bradley County, Tennessee, specifically, three deaths in the past two months?

Answer: *“Yes, I was told of three in the past month and a half to 2 months, one occurring just the previous day.”*

3. Was an inmate brutally beaten beyond facial recognition in the past month by other inmates and was the beating ordered?

Answer: *“Yes, it was reported that one inmate was beaten up out of his shoes so severely that he was un-recognizable, which is common practice. One of the shoes still remained in the room where it happened just the day before. It was reported that there were two of these violations, and the third was that the Guards would take the inmate into a room with a chair having restraints, strapping in the inmate, then several Bradley County Guards would repeatedly use their Tasers on the inmate, which caused a heart attack and the inmate died.”*

“Also, when additional orders are given, the Guards themselves participate in the beatings along with the inmates.”

4. Are inmates ordered to beat specific inmates or murder them for detention center privileges?

Answer: *“They are given the code orders, and it is encouraged for street credibility within the inmate community in the detention center.”*

5. Are detainees or prisoners arbitrarily charged with crimes that happened in other states at the time of being detained in Bradley County, Tennessee?

Answer: *“Yes, there are known cases where the inmates are being charged with crimes out of Georgia, Atlanta particularly being a hotbed for this type of activity. Not only is it across state lines, but inmates are also having false charges placed on them locally while being detained in Bradley County, Tennessee, meaning, that once they’ve served their time, and about to get out, more charges appear, and they are retained in this system longer, and/or charges applied that they couldn’t have done while being inside the detention center.”*

6. Are there codes used by the court staff to indicate a request for arbitrary charges to punish someone for questioning the courts authority?

Answer: *“Yes, one of which is to say ‘Judge, I’m tired’, which means ‘I don’t want to deal with this one anymore.’”*

7. Is the court a private membership association wherein the judges are the trustees?

Answer: *“Yes.”*

8. Do any of the judges in Bradley County, Tennessee own any stocks, interests, shares or are they members and in any way connected with the detention center, directly, or indirectly, either by a trust, LLC, or any other type of entity?

If so, please explain...

Answer: *“Yes, they are members of the Bar Association.”*

9. How many detainees are currently being detained in the detention center in Bradley County, Tennessee that have not been charged, tried nor convicted of anything?

Answer: *“There were several who have been in for months, without knowing when their court dates were going to be scheduled, not knowing who their attorney is going to be, much less even being able to speak to said attorney.”*

“In addition, there are inmates who have been charged falsely with numerous charges, where the inmate was able to successfully prove that they were elsewhere at the time of all the false charges, and months later these same charges remain on the books of the courts against the inmates.”
